 - SC (Subscriber Connector):** Uses a 2.5 mm ceramic ferrule, push-pull latch, suitable for singlemode and multimode fibers, widely used in telecom and data centers.
 - LC (Lucent Connector):** Smaller form factor with 1.25 mm ferrule, often used in high-density applications.
 - ST, FC, MU, E2000:** Each has specific ferrule sizes, locking mechanisms, and applications, with ST being popular for multimode fibers.
 - MT:** Used for ribbon cables, typically in pre-terminated assemblies.
- Splicing:** This creates a permanent joint between two fibers. Splicing is preferred for long-distance or high-bandwidth applications due to its low insertion loss and high durability.
 - Fusion Splicing:** Uses an electric arc to fuse fibers, offering the lowest signal loss (~0.1 dB) and high reliability.
 - Mechanical Splicing:** Aligns fibers using a gel or adhesive, easier to perform but slightly higher signal loss, often used for multimode fibers or temporary repairs.
