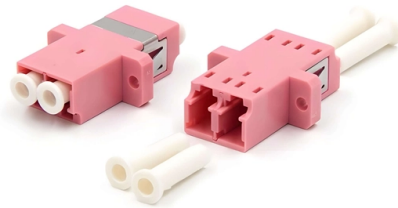

- Micro Cables** Compact and lightweight, micro cables fit into microducts or congested conduits. They are 50–70% smaller and lighter than standard loose tube cables, making them ideal for urban deployments and retrofits ().
- Armored Cables** Feature a metal layer (aluminum or steel) to protect against crushing, rodents, and mechanical abuse. Essential for direct burial installations or areas with high physical risk ().
- Aerial Cables** Suspended on poles or messenger wires, these cables are UV-resistant and designed to withstand wind, ice, and temperature extremes. Figure-8 designs are common for self-supporting aerial installations ().
- Duct Cables** Pulled or blown through underground conduits, duct cables are abrasion-resistant and water-blocked, allowing easier replacement or upgrades compared to direct-buried cables ().
- Drop and Hybrid Cables** Drop cables connect the main backbone to end-user premises, while hybrid cables combine opti...
