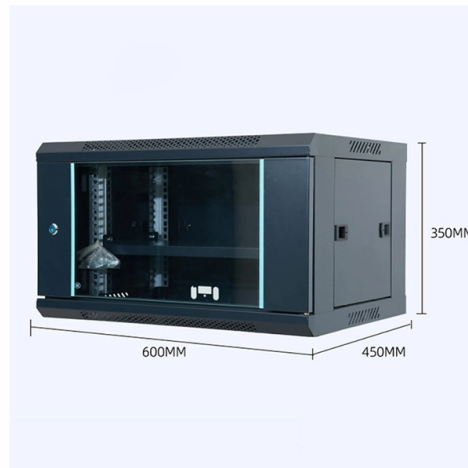


PoE powered switch connected to switch

Connecting a PoE Switch to a Normal Switch

Connecting a PoE Switch to Another PoE Switch
Cascading: You can cascade switches to extend network coverage. There are two main methods:
Uplink Port Cascade: Connect the uplink port of one switch to a standard port on the other switch using a straight-through Ethernet cable. Each cable segment should not exceed 100 meters.
Normal Port Cascade: Connect standard ports on both switches using a crossover cable or a reversed pinout if required by the switch type.
Stacking: Some PoE switches support stacking, where a dedicated stacking port on one switch connects to the stacking port on another switch using a manufacturer-provided cable. Stacked switches can be managed as a single unit.
Power Management: Standard PoE switches can detect powered devices and supply power only when needed, preventing damage. Non-standard PoE switches may not allow PoE ports to connect to non-powered devices, as this could burn the device.
