This step ensures the trays can support heavy cable loads and fit installation requirements.

Welding and Assembly Sections of the tray are welded or assembled to form longer runs or junctions like tees, elbows, and crosses. These components allow for directional changes and complex layouts in cable management systems. Precision welding maintains structural integrity and ensures seamless integration of all parts.

Surface Treatment To enhance durability and corrosion resistance, trays undergo surface treatments such as galvanization, powder coating, or painting. Galvanization protects against rust, powder coating provides a durable finish, and painting can offer both protection and aesthetic appeal.
