It connects to the output terminals of the secondary distribution box, which may include branch circuit breakers and leakage protectors, and feeds into the input terminals of the tertiary box, which contains isolation switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs). The cable routing should allow flexibility for adjustments or expansion, enabling the system to adapt to changes in equipment layout or additional loads. Safety Considerations Each tertiary box typically follows the principle of “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box”, ensuring that faults or overloads in one device do not affect others. The power cord must be properly rated for voltage and current, and installation should comply with local electrical codes to prevent overheating, short circuits, or leakage hazards. In construction or large-scale projects, portable or fixed tertiary boxes may be used, and the power cord should be secured to prevent mechanical damage or accidental disconnection...
