Overview

Secondary distribution is the lower-voltage system after the transformer that serves customer equipment. Moves bulk power over long distances between generation, major substations, and regional load centers. A feeder usually begins with a feeder breaker at the distribution substation. These boxes have inner and outer doors, powder-coated exteriors, and are designed for safety and aesthetic appeal, with rainproof tops for outdoor work. Distribution substations connect to the transmission system and lower the transmission voltage to medium voltage ranging between 2 kV and 33 kV. The Secondary Distribution Box (SDB) receives power from Main Power Distribution box via an extender cable and provides a central power distribution to feed normal branch circuits to the electric floor modules through snap-on extender cables. The SDB can be fitted with terminal blocks for custom. Electrical power distribution system includes various components and processes that ensure a reliable and efficient supply of electrical power at appropriate voltage levels.
