Neat wiring: Use proper wire gauges, secure grounding, and maintain organized cable management. Avoid tangling and ensure wires do not contact sharp edges.

Protective devices: Install circuit breakers, fuses, surge protectors, RCDs, or RCBOs for each circuit to prevent overloads and short circuits.

Spacing and separation: Maintain at least 1 meter distance between high-voltage and low-voltage devices in the same room. Oil-filled equipment should have partitions or be placed in explosion-proof rooms if oil volume exceeds safety thresholds.

Ventilation and Maintenance

Air circulation: Ensure sufficient ventilation to prevent overheating. Consider modular designs for easier upgrades and maintenance.
