- Tertiary Distribution Boards (TDB):** Supply single-phase power (220V) to individual devices or home systems. Each device typically has its own circuit breaker and RCD, following a "one device, one breaker, one RCD" principle to ensure independent protection.

Installation Steps

- Select the Right Distribution Boxes:** Choose boxes based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check IP/NEMA ratings for protection against dust and water, and ensure the material (steel or plastic) suits the installation site.
- Determine Placement:** Install boxes in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters. Ensure proximity to the main power supply and avoid water, flammable, or corrosive substances.
- Prepare Wiring and Connections:** Connect the main power supply to the MDB. Distribute power from...
