Cooling and Airflow Proper airflow is critical. The R730 draws air from the front and exhausts at the rear, so ensure the cabinet has unobstructed front-to-back airflow. Avoid placing the server directly against walls or other equipment that could block ventilation. If multiple servers are installed, consider blanking panels to prevent recirculation of hot air. Maintenance and Serviceability The R730 is designed for easy access to drives, memory, and PCIe cards without removing the server from the rack. Ensure that the cabinet allows sufficient rear clearance for power and network connections, and that the rails are fully extended during maintenance.
