

Recommended Configuration for Factory Core Switches



AI Overview

Factory core switches should be configured for high redundancy, plug-and-play management, and high-speed uplinks to aggregation layers, with careful planning of management VLANs and IP addressing.

Core Layer Design

Redundancy and Resiliency: Deploy two to four core switches in a high-availability configuration to ensure nonstop forwarding and network resiliency. Each core switch should connect to aggregation switches using high-speed links (40-GbE or 100-GbE) to reduce the number of required inter-switch connections and simplify network topology, especially in large campus or factory environments (Fortinet documentation).

Link Aggregation: Use EtherChannel or LAG (Link Aggregation Group) to bundle multiple uplinks between core and aggregation switches. This provides both redundancy and increased bandwidth. For example, each aggregation switch may only need 2x100-GbE links to the core layer instead of multiple direct links to other aggregation switches, reducing cabling complexity.

Management VLAN and IP Configuration

Management Subnet: Configure a dedicated management VLAN on the core switch to act as the gateway for aggregation and access switches. Enable DHCP server functionality on the core switch for dynamic IP assignment, while reserving a portion of the subnet for static IPs for critical devices. A typical configuration might use 192.168.100.1–192.168.100.100 for static IPs and the remaining addresses for dynamic allocation.

Auto-Negotiation: Enable management VLAN auto-negotiation with the core switch as the root device. This allows aggregation and access switches to come online in plug-and-play mode, simplifying large-scale deployments.

Static Routes: Configure static routes on the core switch to ensure proper routing to the management subnet and other network segments. This ensures that all downstream...
