Aluminum: Lightweight and corrosion-resistant, suitable for areas with lower mechanical stress.

Mechanical and Structural Requirements Trays must support the weight of cables without excessive sagging. Load testing is typically performed at spans of 1m, 1.5m, and 2m to ensure deflection and yield strength compliance. Rung spacing for ladder-type trays is generally 150–230 mm to maintain cable support and prevent sagging. Cable trays are not designed for personnel support; they are strictly for cable management.

Fire Resistance and Safety Trays should comply with fire performance requirements, including high-temperature resistance and flame propagation limits. Proper ventilation and fill ratios are critical to prevent overheating of cables in confined underground spaces.
