Accessibility: Panels must be readily accessible for operation, maintenance, and inspection. Adequate working space should be provided around the box.

Environmental Protection: Use enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings to protect against water, dust, and other hazards. Outdoor switchgear must meet at least IP4X, IP5X, or IP6X standards.

Component Requirements: Distribution boxes typically include circuit breakers, fuses, busbars, terminal blocks, and wiring. Double insulation and protective covers are required for live parts in metallic enclosures.

Material Selection: Enclosures are made from steel (powder-coated or epoxy-coated) or engineering thermoplastics like polycarbonate (PC) or ASA, depending on durability and environmental conditions.
