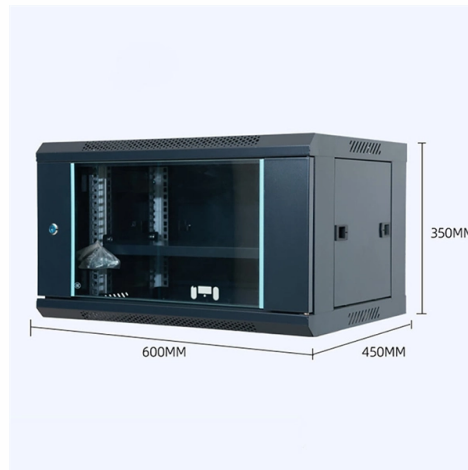


Requirements for Temporary Mobile Distribution Boxes
