

Requirements for lintels during distribution box installation



Overview

All external wall lintels **MUST** be installed with a flexible damp proof course (DPC) or cavity tray. In the case of cavity walls the cavity tray should extend not less than 50mm beyond the cavity return. Prior to installation, the lintel should be examined carefully for any defects or signs of damage. It can be concrete, steel, timber, engineered wood, or a proprietary box/cavity unit. A lintel is a horizontal support, sharper than those of mild steel lintels ! Use of gloves is recommended to handle the lintels ! The weight of some lintels may require the use of a crane; protect fabric straps from the sharp edges ! The lintels may contain CFC-free polystyrene or Rockwool refer to our technical dept. Raise the inner and outer leaves simultaneously to avoid excessive settlement. By following these guidelines, you can guarantee the proper installation and functionality of lintels, contributing to the overall integrity and longevity of your building.
