Considerations The box is designed for 1/2-inch liquid-tight flexible conduit, which can be replaced if damaged. Maximum conduit length between the rooftop box and a weatherproof junction box is 4.5 feet. Each box has designated feed locations for conduit entry, and it can be installed in the middle of a paver or aligned with a seam, depending on the layout. Longer prewired leads can be field-installed by ordering an unwired box and attaching the appropriate wire length. Weatherproofing and Roof Integrity Maintaining roof integrity is critical. All penetrations should be sealed with compatible flashing, gaskets, or sealants to prevent water intrusion. Roof jacks or flashing assemblies are recommended for conduit penetrations, and sealants should remain flexible to accommodate thermal expansion and contraction. Avoid over-compressing sealants, which can create gaps or leaks. Regular inspections are advised to ensure long-term performance and prevent moisture damage.
