Overview

Common warnings include “High Voltage,” “Electric Shock Hazard,” or “Do Not Open While Energized. ” These labels often use orange for the background and bold text to quickly catch attention. The Electrical Safety Foundation International (ESFI) has reported over 2000 electrical workplace injuries and 126 fatalities due to electrical hazards in 2020. The number is way too high and raises some serious concerns: what causes these accidents?

OSHA requires. The National Fire Protection Association's (NFPA) 79 standard requires enclosures that do not clearly show that they contain electrical devices to be marked with a safety sign in accordance with the ANSI Z535 standards. Given that these standards made the older OSHA sign formats obsolete in 2002. Field applied hazard markings must adequately warn of the hazard using effective words and/or colors and/or symbols. Labels act as a visual safety net, providing professionals with the critical information they need to take proper precautions—especially during. To keep a facility safe from electrical hazards, it is necessary to properly mark the panels and the areas around them to minimize any risks.
