Overview

Secondary distribution boxes, also known as sub-distribution boxes, generally serve specific power supply areas. These boxes have inner and outer doors, powder-coated exteriors, and are designed for safety and aesthetic appeal, with rainproof tops for outdoor work. From the transformer's low-voltage side (0.4kV), power is distributed to a main distribution panel (primary distribution box). At this, a distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. Safety is the top priority when. The outgoing line from the low-voltage end of the transformer is 0.
