

Selection Guide for 800G Optical Network Switches for Surveillance Use

Key Considerations

- 1. Optical Transceivers and Form Factors** 800G switches use high-speed transceivers such as OSFP800 and QSFP-DD800, which support multi-vendor interoperability and high-density deployments. For surveillance networks, choose transceivers that support the required wavelengths (850nm–1331nm) and transmission distances, ensuring coverage for both short-range rack-to-rack connections and longer backbone links.
- 2. Link Budget Calculation** The optical link budget is critical for reliable 800G deployment. It accounts for total allowable power loss between transmitter and receiver, including fiber attenuation, connector losses, and environmental factors. Proper link budget planning ensures that high-resolution video streams remain uninterrupted and reduces the risk of signal degradation.
- 3. Cable Types and Distance**
 - Direct Attach Copper (DAC):** Suitable for very short distances (up to 2 meters at 800G) due to high-frequency PAM4 signaling.
 - Active Electrical Cables (AEC):** Bridge the 3–7 meter “dead zone” where passive copper is insufficient but optics may be overkill.
 - Active Optical Cables (AOC) and Optical Fiber:** Ideal for longer distances, providing low latency and high reliability for multi-floor or campus-wide surveillance networks.
- 4. Compatibility and Interoperability** Ensure transceivers are validated for the specific switch platform. Compatibility verification prevents link negotiation issues, performance degradation, and maintains warranty coverage. Cross-platform interoperability is especially important in surveillance networks with mixed vendor equipment.
