QSFP28 LR4: Single-mode module with 4 WDM wavelengths, supports up to 10 km. Suitable for connecting buildings or data centers within a city like Dakar, offering a balance of cost and reach.

Long-Reach Links (Metro or Regional Networks)

Cisco QSFP28 100G ZR: Coherent optics module capable of 80 km over dark fiber and up to 300 km over amplified DWDM links. Cost-effective for upgrading multiple 10G wavelengths to 100G without replacing existing fiber infrastructure. Supports low latency and precise timing, ideal for wireless x-haul, campus interconnects, and data center interconnects.

Fiber Type: Ensure compatibility with existing single-mode or multi-mode fiber. SR4 is for MMF, LR4/ZR for SMF.
