The MDB is typically designed to accommodate the total load of the building and provide space for future expansion. Enclosures are made from materials like cold-rolled steel, stainless steel, or thermoplastics, with protection ratings up to IP54 for indoor or outdoor use .

Sub-Distribution Boxes (SDB) Sub-distribution boxes receive power from the main distribution box and distribute it to localized circuits, such as lighting, power outlets, or specific machinery . Their configuration depends on the load requirements and installation environment:

- Number of Ways (Circuits):** Commonly 4, 6, 8, 12, 18, or 24 circuits .
- Voltage & Phase:** Typically 230V single-phase or 400V three-phase .
- Protective Devices:** Miniature circuit breakers (MCBs), RCDs, and surge protection as needed
