- Tertiary Distribution (Final Distribution or Equipment-Level Boards):** This level supplies power directly to end-use devices, typically 220V single-phase. Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs) are installed here, often with Type B, C, or D tripping curves depending on the load type. Each device or outlet is protected individually, following the principle of "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box".

Safety and Coordination Principles

- Current Selectivity:** The upstream breaker's instantaneous trip setting must exceed the maximum fault current of the downstream breaker to prevent unnecessary disconnection.
- Time Selectivity:** Upstream breakers operate with a short delay, while downstream breakers act instantaneously to isolate faults quickly.
- Energy Selectivity:** Current-limiting characteristics of breakers are used to reduce fault energy and protect equipment.
- Leakage Protection:** Terminal circuits must include RCBOs or RCDs to disconnect o...
