

Should network cabinets use dust filters



Overview

Investing in dustproof accessories can provide an additional layer of protection for your network cabinet. Dust filters, for example, can be placed over air intakes to trap particles before they enter the cabinet. In addition to regular light cleaning, scheduling deeper cleans every few months is essential. This may involve more. What is the best way to control dust?

Preferably use a special vacuum cleaner that filters the dust well and does not blow it out again. Instead.
