Bend Radius: Maintain the minimum bend radius recommended for the fiber type to avoid microbends or breakage. Workspace: Use a clean, well-lit area to prevent contamination and make fiber handling easier. Safety: The hot melt oven operates at high temperatures (245–270°C), so handle with care to avoid burns. By following this sequence—clamp the fiber in the hot melt connector first, allow the adhesive to set, then coil the fiber—you ensure a secure, low-loss termination and a neatly organized fiber layout suitable for long-term performance.
