For 100A service, copper conductors are typically #4 AWG, while aluminum may require #2 AWG, depending on local codes and temperature ratings. Grounding: The main panel must have a Main Bonding Jumper (MBJ) connecting neutral and ground bars. In sub-panels, neutral and ground must remain separate to prevent ground faults. Protection Devices: Include main breakers, fuses, and surge protection. Each branch circuit should have its own breaker for safety and compliance. Labeling: All circuits must be clearly labeled to identify the equipment or area served, as required by NEC 408.4. IEC and Industrial Considerations For industrial or high-capacity installations, IEC 61439 standards recommend sizing conductors according to load current, ambient temperature, and allowable temperature rise. Copper is preferred for its conductivity, and the earth conductor should be at least half the size of the largest phase conductor, but not less than 6 mm². Proper ventilation and cable management are also critical to prevent overheating and maintain long-term reliability.
