Electrical Socket Configuration In a typical single-phase domestic distribution box, the main power supply is connected to a double-pole MCB (Main Circuit Breaker), which controls the overall power to the house. From there, single-pole MCBs distribute power to individual circuits such as lighting, sockets, and appliances. For special high-power loads, double-pole MCBs may be used. An RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) is essential for protection against leakage currents, electrical shocks, and insulation faults, and its rating should match the main MCB to ensure coordinated protection ().

Data Socket Configuration For network and communication wiring, Cat6 cables are recommended for home networks due to their high-speed capability. These cables should terminate in RJ45 modular sockets mounted in a patch panel or wall plates. Each room should have at least one RJ45 outlet, with multiple cables running from the home distribution box to key locations like the main entertainment hub. Leave at least 300mm of slack at each outlet to allow for adjustments (). Keystone jacks are commonly used as female connectors in wall plates or patch panels, while the matching male connectors attach to the cable ends. Avoid mixing Cat5 and Cat6 components to maintain performance, as Cat6 jacks are designed for thicker copper wires and insulation ().

Layout and Best Practices Centralized wiring: Bring all cables from wall sockets to a central distribution box for easier management and future upgrades. Conduit use: Run 20mm PVC conduits from the distribution box to external entry points for fibre or telephone lines, ensuring no sharp bends to protect cable integrity ().
