Recommended mounting height for residential distribution boards is 1–1.8 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users. Adequate clearance and working space must be provided around the panel for safe operation and maintenance.

U.S. Standards (NEC/NFPA 70): The National Electrical Code (NEC) governs residential electrical installations in the U.S., including panelboards, grounding, and protective devices. NEC specifies proper circuit ratings (15–20 A for general outlets), wire gauge (14–12 AWG), and the use of GFCI and AFCI protection in kitchens, bathrooms, and other high-risk areas. Wall-mounted distribution boxes should be readily accessible, though specific height requirements are guided by common practice rather than code.
