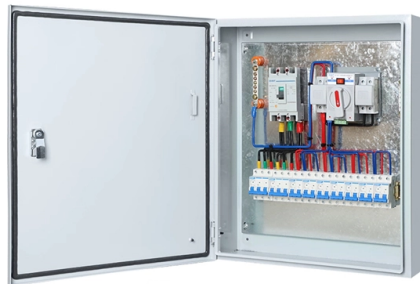


Standard Requirements for Secondary Distribution Boxes under Power Requirement

Electrical Ratings and Transformer Requirements Secondary distribution boxes typically include three-phase power transformers and low-voltage switchgear. Transformers are rated according to the load demand and are often oil-immersed or dry-type, with cores made of high-permeability, grain-oriented steel or amorphous metal to reduce losses and noise (Eaton). The transformer capacity should match the expected load, and secondary fault currents must be considered for proper breaker sizing. Tap changers may be externally operable for voltage regulation.

Enclosure and Mechanical Requirements Enclosures must be weather-resistant, dust-proof, and NEMA-rated for outdoor installations, or comply with indoor environmental conditions for indoor substations. Materials include glass-reinforced plastic, brick, or metal, depending on site conditions. Enclosures should allow easy access for maintenance, provide adequate ventilation or cooling, and include alarm contacts for oil level, temperature, and pressure monitoring.

Earthing and Safety Proper earthing of transformers and switchgear is essential to ensure safety and minimize fault currents. Ground pads should be non-corrosive, stainless steel or copper-faced, and connected to a reliable grounding system. Fire resistance and insulation standards must be met, particularly for outdoor or padmount substations.
