Hierarchical Layout

Construction site power distribution is usually organized in multiple levels:

- Main Distribution Box:** Located near the primary power supply, serving as the central hub.
- Sub-Distribution Boxes:** Positioned near clusters of electrical equipment or high-load areas, typically within 30 meters of the main box.
- Switch Boxes:** Final distribution points controlling specific equipment, installed within 3 meters of the devices they serve.

Installation Guidelines

- Location:** Boxes should be installed in ventilated, dry areas away from harmful media (gas, steam, liquids) and heat sources.
- Accessibility:** Ensure enough space for two people to operate and maintain the boxes safely, with no obstructions or stacked items.
- Construction:** Boxes are made of iron plate (>1.5mm) or high-quality insulating material, with internal mounting plates for electrical equipment.
- Wiring:** Use insulated wires with secure connections; separate working neutral and protective neutral lines via terminal blocks.
- Separation of Circuits:** Power and lighting circuits should be separated, either in different boxes or...

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The distribution box shall be set below the main distribution box, and the switch box shall be set below the distribution box, and the electrical equipment shall be set below the switch box.
