Industrial panels may have specific size limits, e.g., maximum width 1.5 m, height 1.2 m, depth 0.5 m for IP54-rated enclosures. Electrical Components and Wiring Inside the box, components include circuit breakers, busbars, terminal blocks, DIN rails, and wiring. Wiring must use high-temperature resistant copper conductors with cross-sectional areas matching load requirements. Proper insulation, neat cable management, and secure connections are essential. Each circuit should have overcurrent protection via breakers or fuses, and surge protection is recommended.
