Electrical Safety and Wiring: Proper grounding and earthing are mandatory to protect personnel and equipment from electrical faults. Use correct wire gauges, secure cable management, and ensure each circuit has its own protection devices such as circuit breakers, fuses, or surge protectors. Residual Current Devices (RCDs) and Arc Fault Detection Devices (AFDDs) may be required depending on the installation type.
