

Switch power failure alarm access

Power failure alarms on network switches can be accessed and configured via alarm input/output ports, LED indicators, and software settings to monitor and respond to power supply issues.

Accessing Power Failure Alarms

Most managed switches, such as Cisco ME3400E, IE3500, and Juniper QFX Series, provide multiple ways to access power failure alarms:

- Alarm Inputs/Outputs:** Switches have dedicated alarm input ports to connect external devices (e.g., fire alarms, temperature sensors) and alarm outputs to trigger relays or external notifications. Inputs can detect open or closed circuits, and outputs can be configured as normally open or normally closed to signal a fault.
- LED Indicators:** Switches display alarm status using LEDs. For example, minor alarms may show amber, major alarms red, and critical alarms blinking red. These LEDs indicate power supply failures, missing inputs, or insufficient output.
- System Messages and CLI:** Triggered alarms generate system messages that can be viewed via the switch CLI or web interface. On Juniper QFX switches, commands like `show chassis alarms` or `show system alarms` display major and minor alarms, including power supply failures.
- Configuring Alarm Behavior**
 - Severity Levels:** Alarms can be set to minor, major, or critical. Severity affects LED color and system messages.
 - Trigger Settings:** Alarm inputs can be configured to trigger on open or closed circuits. Open means the alarm is generated when current stops flowing; closed means the alarm is generated when current flows.
 - Power Supply Monitoring:** On switches with redundant power supplies (e.g., Cisco IE3500 Rugged Series), alarms can be configured to notify when a supply is missing, has no input, or insufficient output. Commands like `power-supply dual` or `no power-supply dual` control whether the switch expects one or two power supplies and whether missing supply alarms are generated.
- Integration with Network Monitoring**
 - Syslog and Dashboards:** Alarms can be logged via Syslog or displayed on network management dashboards to ensure real-time monitoring and...
