- Coverage:** Ensure the router's range matches your home or office size. TP-Link models like the Archer AX90 or AX55 provide reliable coverage for small to medium homes .
- Advanced Features:** Some models support VPN, parental controls, and QoS, which can enhance security and network management .

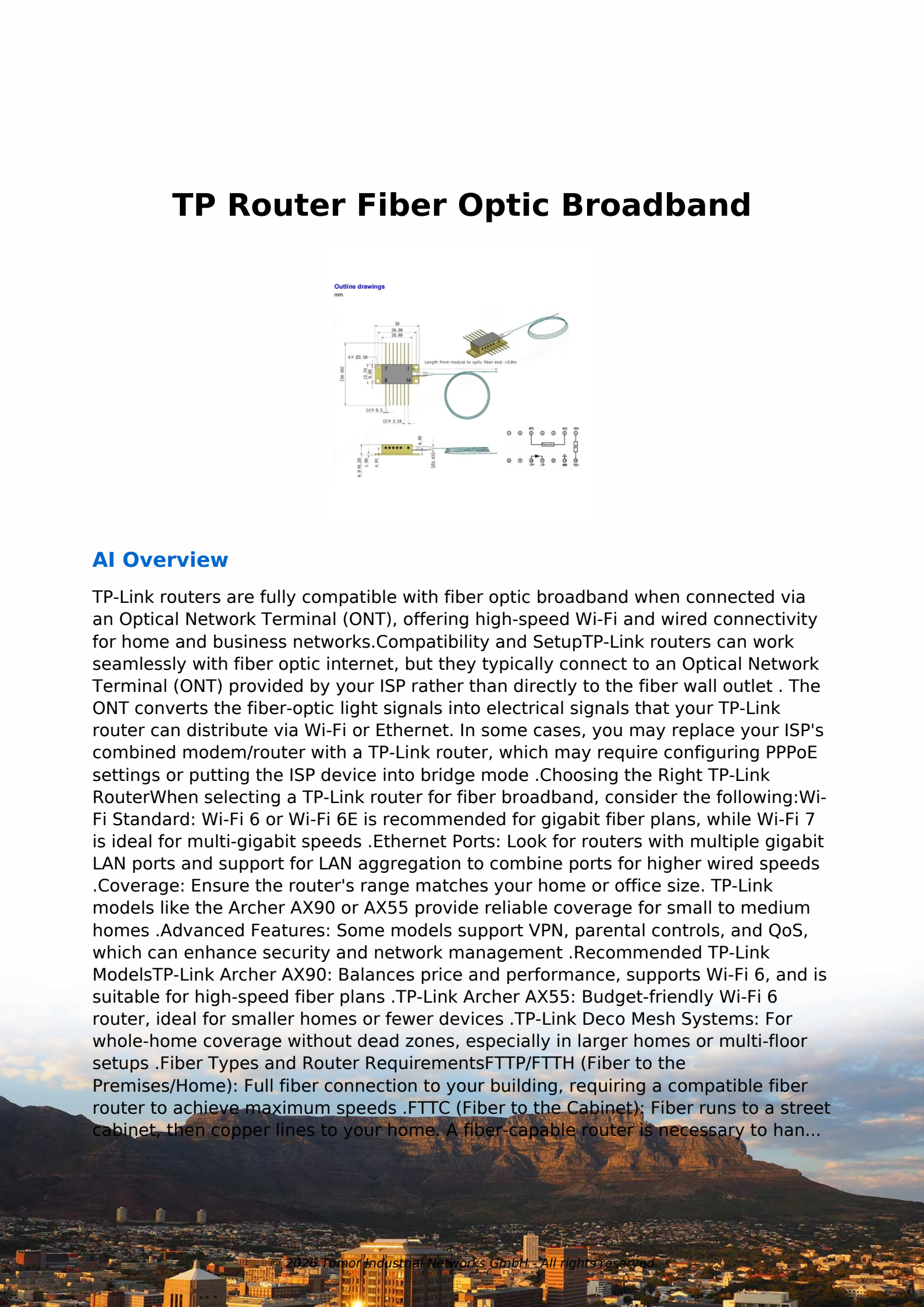
