- Pre-fabricated elbows (45° or 90°)** can simplify complex routing and ensure consistent angles.
- Maintain Proper Bend Radius** Follow NEC guidelines for minimum bend radii to prevent conductor damage. Avoid bends that are too tight, which can flatten or kink the wire, potentially cutting insulation and creating fire hazards.
- Plan for Take-Up and Gain**
 - Take-Up:** the length of conduit consumed by the bend. Subtract this from your measurement to ensure accurate placement.
 - Gain:** the extra length produced because the diagonal path of the bend is shorter than the sum of straight sections. Accounting for both ensures precise conduit routing.
- Use Flexible Conduit for Tight Spaces** Flexible metal or plastic conduits allow easier routing in confined distribution boxes without sharp bends. They reduce the risk of insulation damage and simplify adjustments during installation.
- Mark and Measure Accurately** Measure from reference points (corners, terminal blocks) and mark the conduit or wire before bending. Include extra length to account for bends, especially in complex layouts.
- Follow Wiring Layout Standards** Maintain clear separation of circuits, proper...
