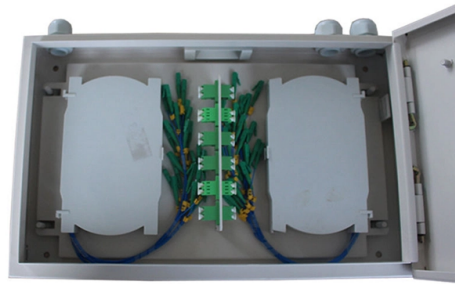


Test the quality of the light curtain with a multimeter
