Cable Tray Type Selection

This can be controlled by drilling 1/4 inch drain holes in the bottom of the cable tray at three foot intervals (at the middle and very near the sides) if the cable tray is not being used for EMI/RFI shielding.

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If a cable tray system passes under an open walkway, the cables should be protected from possible falling objects in the immediate area. Should a cable tray system temporarily be subjected to falling
