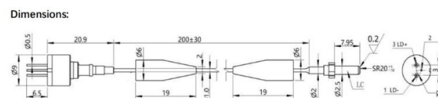

- Safety Devices:** Includes circuit breakers, leakage protection, and sometimes surge protection to ensure safe operation of connected appliances.
- Installation:** Can be wall-mounted or pole-mounted, with pre-wired options available for easier setup. Proper wiring requires distinguishing live (L) and neutral (N) connections according to the wiring diagram.
