- Secondary Distribution Box:** Serves as an intermediate distribution point, routing power to specific buildings, floors, or zones. It handles three-phase power and connects to larger loads such as motors or machinery. Secondary boxes are equipped with larger three-phase circuit breakers and may include protective features like dual-door protection and rainproof coatings for outdoor use.
- Tertiary Distribution Box:** The final distribution point, supplying power directly to end-use equipment or household systems, usually at 220V single-phase. Tertiary boxes implement strict safety standards, following the principle of “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box”, ensuring independent protection for each device. They may be fixed or portable and include RCDs for leakage protection.

Safety and Protection Features

- Two-Level Protection:** Leakage protection is installed at both the secondary and tertiary levels to prevent electrical hazards.
- Independent Circuit Control:** Each device or appliance is controlled by its own circuit breaker and RCD, preventing a single fault from affecting multiple devices.
