Inner Fiber Color Sequence For multi-fiber cables, each fiber is assigned a specific color in a 12-fiber repeating sequence: Blue Orange Green Brown Slate (Gray) White Red Black Yellow Violet Rose (Pink) Aqua (Light Blue). For cables exceeding 12 fibers, the sequence repeats in groups, often using colored buffer tubes or stripes to maintain unique identification. Outer Jacket and Connector Colors Outer Jacket Colors: Indicate fiber type and mode (e.g., OS2, OM3, OM4, OM5). For example, yellow jackets typically denote single-mode fibers, while orange or aqua may indicate multimode fibers. Connector/Boot Colors: Identify polish type and fiber mode, such as UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact), and single-mode or multimode classification. High-Fiber-Count Cables For cables with more than 12 fibers, a tube-and-fiber system is used. Each buffer tube is color-coded, and fibers inside follow the standard 12-color sequence. For example, Fiber #34 in a 48-fiber cable would be the 10th fiber (Violet) in the 3rd tube (Green) to ensure unique identification.
