- Safety Factor:** Ladder trays are designed with a safety factor of at least 1.5, ensuring that the tray can support the static cable weight plus additional allowance.

- Hot-Dip Galvanization:** Provides uniform corrosion protection on all surfaces, including joints and edges.
- Powder Coating or Mill Galvanization:** Alternative finishes for indoor or less corrosive environments.
- Compliance:** Trays are manufactured according to NEMA VE-1 or equivalent IEC standards, ensuring consistent thickness and mechanical performance.

Practical Recommendation

For typical installations in Syria or similar environments, a 2 mm thick steel side rail with 150 mm rung spacing is commonly used for medium-duty applications. For heavier cable loads or longer spans, 3 mm thickness is recommended. Always verify with the manufacturer or local standards to ensure co...
