Conduits, usually HDPE or PVC, are installed to protect the cable from mechanical damage, moisture, and rodent activity. Conduits should be straight, continuous, and avoid sharp bends to maintain the fiber's minimum bend radius.

Cable Installation Two main methods are used: conduit pulling and direct burial. Conduit pulling is preferred in urban or high-traffic areas, allowing easier future upgrades. Direct burial is suitable for rural or stable areas, often using armored fiber cables for added protection. During installation, cables must be pulled steadily, maintaining tension below the rated limit, and bend radius must be controlled using pulleys or guide devices to prevent signal loss.

Cable Protection and Accessories Sub-ducts may be used inside larger conduits to optimize space and facilitate future cable replacement. Marker tapes are placed above buried cables to indicate their location for future excavations. Splice closures secure cable joints, and protective measures are taken against environmental and mechanical hazards.
