Tray type: Wire basket cable trays are commonly used because they are sturdy, ventilated, and allow easy access for maintenance. Depth and layering: Standard trays should not exceed 6 inches (150mm) in depth. If more capacity is needed, multiple layers or cantilever systems can be installed to accommodate growth and allow access to existing cables. Best Practices Secure mounting: Ensure trays are properly anchored to prevent sagging or falling, which could damage cables or create hazards. Avoid overcrowding: Do not exceed the tray's weight limit; overcrowding can reduce airflow and make maintenance difficult. Accessibility: Position trays so cables are easy to reach for troubleshooting or upgrades, without obstructing equipment or personnel movement. Grounding: Metallic trays should be bonded to the data center grounding infrastructure to prevent electrical hazards.
