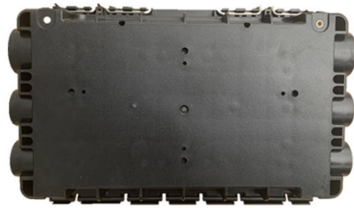

When the device name is the only argument to `ethtool`, it prints the current settings of the network device.
