CoreThe core is the central part of the fiber where light signals travel. CoatingThe coating or buffer layer protects the core and cladding from physical damage, moisture, and environmental stress. It is usually made of acrylate polymer or polyimide and does not affect the optical properties but prevents scratches and microbends that could degrade signal quality.

Strengthening FibersStrengthening fibers, often made of aramid yarn (e.g., Kevlar), provide tensile strength to the cable, preventing stretching and breakage during installation or environmental stress. In some outdoor or armored cables, additional steel or glass rods may be included for extra protection.

Outer JacketThe outer jacket is the visible protective layer that shields the internal components from mechanical damage, moisture, chemicals, and UV exposure. Jacket materials vary depending on the application, such as indoor, outdoor, direct burial, or submarine installations.
