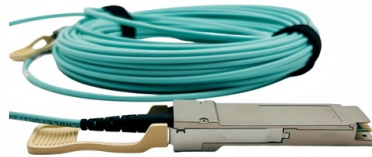


What are the five circuits in a distribution box
