 - Using watertight enclosures or handholes for splices.
 - Avoiding placement in areas prone to flooding or mud accumulation.
 - Ensuring proper strain relief and avoiding sharp bends beyond the cable's minimum bend radius.
- Mechanical Considerations**
Support cables with mid-span clamps if spans exceed recommended lengths (typically 150 feet for messenger-supported drops). Avoid crushing, kinking, or excessive pulling forces during installation to prevent signal degradation. Use drip loops where necessary to prevent water from entering connectors or enclosures.
