**FC (Ferrule Connector):** Features a threaded coupling for secure connections in high-vibration environments such as factories or railway networks. FC connectors are typically used in single-mode fiber applications requiring high precision.

**MTP/MPO:** Multi-fiber connectors used for high-density, high-speed applications, often in data centers and backbone networks. They allow multiple fibers to be connected simultaneously, improving efficiency in large-scale deployments.
