

What causes white spots on the cross-section of a fiber optic cable patch cord

5. Contamination Transfer Connecting a contaminated fiber to a clean port can transfer debris, creating visible spots on previously clean fibers. This is common in patch cords that are frequently connected and disconnected .

Prevention and Mitigation Always inspect fiber endfaces with a microscope before connecting. Use lint-free wipes and approved solvents like isopropyl alcohol for cleaning . Keep protective caps on until the fiber is ready to be connected. Avoid touching the endface and handle fibers in clean environments. Re-inspect after cleaning to ensure all contaminants are removed.
