Identify each fiber using the 12-color sequence. Numbering may also be printed on the fibers for easier identification.

Match connectors to the fiber type to ensure proper termination and avoid mixing APC and UPC connectors. By combining jacket color, fiber color sequence, and connector type, a technician can reliably identify a 12-core optical fiber cable and its individual fibers for installation, splicing, or testing.
