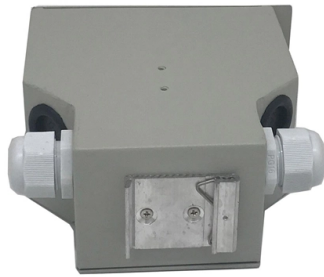


What maintenance methods are used for communication optical cables

Inspection and Testing Routine inspection helps detect potential issues before they affect network performance. Use OTDR (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer) testing to establish baseline measurements and monitor changes in insertion loss or return loss over time. Critical links should be inspected every 6-12 months, focusing on connector end-face condition and signal attenuation. Avoid unnecessary network downtime by relying on built-in equipment monitoring rather than frequent physical checks, as fiber systems are generally designed to operate without constant intervention.

Environmental Control Environmental factors significantly impact fiber performance. Maintain temperature between 18-27°C and relative humidity of 40-60% to prevent micro-bending losses caused by thermal expansion or contraction. Implement dust control measures, such as high-efficiency air filters and anti-static cleaning, especially in data centers. Seal spare cables and patch cords to prevent contamination.

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Optical fibres in an installed cable have residual strains from tension, torsion and bending. Bent fibres in a closure suffer larger strains than those in a cable (as for fibre strain in installed cable, refer to
