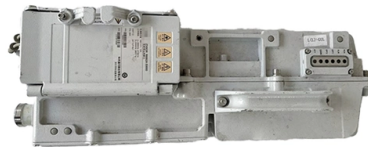


What to put on a cable management rack

Plan Horizontal First, Then Vertical – Run cables horizontally to the edge of the rack, then vertically along cable managers to maintain order. Avoid Over-Bundling – Especially for high-power PoE++ devices, loose bundling prevents overheating and maintains thermal efficiency. Maintain Airflow – Ensure cable bundles do not block ventilation paths to prevent overheating of switches and servers. Future-Proofing – Leave extra U-space (around 30%) for additional equipment and verify rack depth for modern switches and devices. By combining these components and practices, a cable mana...
